Specific Benefits from Measure B – City of Santa Clara

Uncommon allies united for a common goal: Relieve Traffic; Repair our Roads. That's why the League of Women Voters, Santa Clara Chamber of Commerce, League of Conservation Voters, former U.S. Transportation Secretary Norman Mineta and Senator Dianne Feinstein are championing Measure B to provide vital local funding to fill potholes, maintain roads and reduce traffic throughout Santa Clara County.

We are fortunate to enjoy a special quality of life here. Unfortunately, many of Santa Clara County's roads are in dire need of repair and we're spending too much time trapped in traffic. We need meaningful countywide congestion relief.

Local Road Maintenance Funds

- ▶ Each city will receive funds annually, based on population and road miles, over the 30 year span of the measure. For the City of Santa Clara that amount is more than \$70 million.

Expressway Congestion Relief

- ▶ Central at Thompson intersection improvement
- ▶ Add Eastbound through lane at Lawrence and Homestead Rd.
- ▶ Grade separate Lawrence at Homestead Rd.
- ▶ Provide grade separations and remove traffic signals on Lawrence at every intersection from Reed/Monroe to Arques.
- ▶ Montague from Great Mall to Trade Zone
- ▶ Montague eastbound auxiliary lane from Trade Zone to Main/Oakland
- ▶ Montague from Main/Oakland to McCarthy/O'Toole (inc. I-880 interchange)
- ▶ SR 17/San Tomas improvements
- ▶ San Tomas between Homestead and Stevens Creek

**Some improvements impact traffic relief in Santa Clara but are not located within city limits*



Highway Interchange Improvements

- ▶ I-280/Lawrence Expressway/Stevens Creek Boulevard
- ▶ SR 237 Corridor between Zanker Road and North First Street and at Great America Parkway
- ▶ US 101/Trimble Road/De La Cruz Boulevard to Zanker Road Area



BART to Silicon Valley Phase Two

- ▶ Four additional BART stations to connect with Santa Clara (Alum Rock Station, Downtown San Jose Station, Diridon Station, Santa Clara Station)

Countywide Improvements

- ▶ Mass transit operations, targeting low income, seniors, students and people with disabilities
- ▶ Additional bicycle and pedestrian improvements, especially near schools
